



Rear Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted. Keep all components removed.

- 1. Raise rear of machine off ground, secure with jack stands, remove Wheels, and disconnect Shocks from Mount.
- 2. Remove Air Lines from Mount. See Fig. 1.
- Drill out hole in Mount as shown in Fig. 1a. Only left side will be drilled. Use a Ø8mm Drill Bit.
- 3. Install Rear Brackets (A) to Mount. Fore Rear Bracket (A) will install to *inside* of Mount and aft Rear Bracket (A) will install to *outside* of Mount. See Figs. 2 2b.
- M8 Flat Washer will go between Mount and Rear Bracket (A). See Figs. 2 2b.
- Install provided Spacers, as shown in Figs. 2 2b, and secure components with M10-1.50 x 60mm Lg. FHCS, M10-1.50 Nylock Nut, M8-1.25 x 60mm Lg. FHCS, and M8-1.25 Nylock Nut. See Figs. 2 2b.
- 4. Install Shocks to Rear Brackets (A) with M10-1.50 x 60mm Lg. FHCS and M10-1.50 Nylock Nuts.
- 5. Tighten all hardware completely.







Front Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted. Keep all components removed.

- 1. Raise front of machine off ground, secure with jack stands and remove Wheels.
- Remove Inner Fenders. See Fig. 3.
- Drill out Rivets, remove hardware, and pull Mounts from machine. See Figs. 3a 3b.
- Disconnect Shocks from Mount.
- 2. Remove Tie Rods from Steering Post, and install Steering Stop (B) to Steering Post with stock hardware. See Fig. 4.
- 3. Install Front Brackets (C) to Mounts. Secure with M5-.80 x 16mm Lg. FHCS, M5-.80 Nylock Nuts, M8-1.25 x 25mm Lg. FHCS, and M8-1.25 Nylock Nut. See Figs. 5 5b.
- 4. Install Shocks to Front Brackets (C) with M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. FHCS and M10-1.50 Nylock Nuts Thin.
- 5. Tighten all hardware completely.
